WFAS International Symposium of Acupuncture 2006 is scheduled to convene on 24-26 November 2006, in Bali, Indonesia.

It is hosted by World Federation of Acupuncture-Moxibustion Societies (WFAS), and organized by the National Acupuncture Union of Indonesia (PAKSI).

At present the symposium is still under preparation, the theme of the Symposium is “The Development of Acupuncture in Health’s Promotion, Prevention, Treatment and Rehabilitation, based on Rationale, Evidence, and Scientific Approaches.”, and the expected amount of participants is about 400-500.

During the symposium, on the afternoon of November 24th, the Secretariat of WFAS will hold the third session of Plenary Conference of the sixth Executive Committee of WFAS. Meanwhile, the Secretariat of WFAS will report to the Executive Committee about the work of the past two years and the cooperation plan between WFAS and WHO in the following three years.
